Tasting Local Cabernet Franc

Wenatchee Valley Museum & Cultural Center
Thursday, March 19th at 7pm

Cabernet Franc is best known as one of the six classic Bordeaux varietals. While Cabernet Franc first earned its popularity in the Loire Valley in the 1700's, when it was known by its original name, Bouchet, perhaps its greatest claim to fame is due to the fact that it gave birth to Cabernet Sauvignon after it was crossed with Sauvignon Blanc.



Cabernet Franc has been of primary value for the sturdy core and firm tannins it adds to softer wines. On its own, it offers delicious, spicy notes with mellow coffee and intense blueberry fruit.

Grown in the Evergreen State for many decades, it is known as a hardy variety that can withstand the occasionally harsh winters that descend on our area. Washington vineyard acreage devoted to Cabernet Franc has grown six-fold in the past few years.
